V-TOL Warrigal Tactical Mini-UAV Update

V-TOL has recently completed a series of trials to test the capabilities & limitations of the Warrigal Tactical Mini-UAV. The Warrigal proto-type 001 has completed over 60 hours of flight testing. Warrigals 002 & 003 will test the improvements learnt from 001 and will also operate as part of V-TOL Unmanned Flight Services (UFS).
